Background

Fletcher Construction was the principal contractor for the refurbishment of the former Dominion Museum building, the former Annex, and the surrounding site works for the Massey University Wellington campus. In recognition of the completion of the project Fletcher Construction donated a sum of \$15,000 in June 2002 to support these awards.

Value and Tenure

The value of the bursary will be up to \$1,500 and is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, two bursaries will be awarded per year, one each in nursing and design.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- New Zealand citizens or permanent residents
- studying full time at the Wellington campus in either; year two of the Bachelor of Nursing, or year three of the Bachelor of Design (Spatial Design) and intending to enrol in the Honours year

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on academic merit.

Achievement in papers related to health promotion in the community and Maori Health will be considered for Bachelor of Nursing applicants.

Selection Panel

The bursary is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the College of Creative Arts Representative on the University Scholarships Committee, and one academic staff member from the College of Health.

Conditions of the Bursary

The selection committee may relax or modify the application of these regulations in special circumstances.

Payment of each bursary will be made in one lump sum, following confirmation of enrolment.
