## **Level of Study**

Undergraduate, Third Year

# **Purpose**

The purpose of the Magnetic Resonance Scholarship is to support third-year physics students with their study at Massey University.

## **Background**

The Magnetic Resonance Scholarship was established by the former Department of Physics using money made from its commercial activities of manufacturing and selling nuclear magnetic resonance probes and field gradient coils.

#### **Value and Tenure**

The value of the scholarship is determined by available funds; in recent years this has been \$1,000.

The tenure is for a single year.

#### **Typical Number on Offer**

One scholarship is typically offered each year, funds permitted.

## Eligibility

Applicants must be enrolled in the Bachelor of Science for the third-year majoring requirements in Physics.

#### **Selection Criteria**

The selection criterion is the aggregate results in the 200-level physics papers required for the major in physics.

## **Selection Panel**

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Physics Department, Massey University

# **Conditions of the Scholarship**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.

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
