Agricultural science, horticultural science and agricommerce

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

The Agcarm Undergraduate Agricultural Scholarship supports undergraduate agricultural, horticultural and agribusiness students.

Background

Agcarm is the peak industry association of companies which manufacture, distribute and sell products that keep animals healthy and crops thriving.

Value and Tenure

The value of a scholarship is \$2,500.

The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- be studying full time for a Bachelor of Agricultural Science, Bachelor of Horticultural Science, Bachelor of Agribusiness or Bachelor of Science (Agricultural Science) at Massey University
- have completed the first year of their degree programme

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit
- personal statement
- CV
- a 600-word essay outlining why the applicant is studying their chosen programme

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of Agcarm Inc.

The selection panel has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.
