Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Agriculture, Horticulture

Level of Study

Undergraduate and Postgraduate

Background

The William Reed Scholarships are open to ex-pupils of the Palmerston North Boys High School and are tenable at Massey University.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship shall have a value determined each year from the interest earned on the capital. In recent years this has been \$2,000.

The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically one scholarship will be awarded per year

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- enrolled full-time
- enrolled in a bachelor's degree, postgraduate degree or postgraduate diploma in Applied Academic Programme disciplines relevant to agriculture or horticulture (prefix of 112, 117, 119, 189, 283, 284 or 285)
- an ex-pupil of Palmerston North Boys High School

Selection Criteria

The selection criterion is academic merit.

Selection Panel

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee, College of Sciences.

Conditions of the Scholarship

In recommending the award of the scholarships the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee shall take account of other scholarships and bursaries held with a view to achieving a reasonable distribution of monies among qualifying candidates.

The scholarship shall be offered annually but will not be awarded if no suitable candidates apply.

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as these permit co-tenure.
