

# Anexa Vets Study Grant

## Grant Regulations

### **Focus**

Veterinary Science

### **Level of Study**

Undergraduate

### **Purpose**

To support Bachelor of Veterinary Science fourth year students who have a interest in large animal production medicine.

### **Value and Tenure**

The value of the grant is \$3,000 and is tenable for two years.

### **Typical Number on Offer**

Typically, two grants will be awarded annually.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be:

- studying full time in a Bachelor of Veterinary Science at Massey University
- enrolled in the fourth year of study
- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident, and normally reside in New Zealand

### **Selection Criteria**

Selection will be based on:

- demonstrated interest in general practice with an emphasis on large animal production medicine
- academic results from the previous two years of study
- applicant's CV
- two referee letters

## **Selection Committee**

The grant is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of Anexa Vets.

## **Conditions of the Grant**

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview, held at Massey University with veterinarians from Anexa Vets.

It is expected that the successful candidates shall see practice with Anexa Vets for one week in the spring of their fourth year and for another week in their fifth year. These two weeks are over and above the week of Externship that they may spend with Anexa Vets.

Receipt of the second year of the award is dependant on the recipients passing the fourth year of study.

This grant may be held concurrently with any other scholarship, bursary, or award, provided this is not considered to constitute a conflict of interest.
