Purpose

The Norwood Undergraduate Scholarship supports ambitious and enthusiastic students wishing to undertake a career in agriculture or horticulture.

Background

Value and Tenure

The value of each scholarship is up to \$2000.

The scholarship is offered annually and the tenure is for a single academic year.

Typical Number on Offer

Three scholarships are typically offered each year.

Eligibility

Applicants must be undertaking a full-time undergraduate degree in agriculture or horticulture at Massey University. Preference may be given to 3rd Year students.

Selection Criteria

The selection is based on academic merit and the applicant's CV.

Consideration will also be given to how the applicant hopes to contribute to the future of agriculture/horticulture in their future career as described in a personal statement. Students taking some or all of the following papers in their 3rd Year may be considered more favourably:

The selection panel will also take account of other scholarships and bursaries held by the applicants in seeking an equitable distribution of funds

Selection Panel

The scholarship is awarded by representatives from Norwood on the recommendation of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee, College of Sciences.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Norwood has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

Applications are welcome from previous recipients who are continuing in their programme of study and have demonstrated good academic progress.
