Level of Study

Postgraduate

Purpose

The purpose of the postgraduate scholarship is to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding women who undertake post-graduate study or research.

Graduate Women New Zealand believe in empowering women through education, advocacy and community.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is a one-off grant between \$4,000 and \$8,000. The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Dependant on available funding, typically between eight to twelve awards are available annually.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- female
- currently enrolled at Massey University in a master's degree or the final year of a postgraduate honours

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on the applicant's:

- academic profile and achievements
- financial situation
- personal profile

Selection Panel

The selection process is undertaken by Graduate Women Manawatū Charitable Trust. The panel's decision is final.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The Graduate Women Manawatu Postgraduate Scholarship can be awarded to an individual once only during a student's programme of postgraduate study.

By submitting an application, the applicant consents to:

- The disclosure of their personal information to staff within the University and members of Graduate Women Manawatu Charitable Trust selection committee, for the purpose of assessing the application
- Graduate Women Manawatu Charitable Trust publishing the names of successful applicants on its website
- Graduate Women Manawatu Charitable Trust forwarding the name and contact details of successful applicants to Graduate Women Manawatu for the purpose of introducing the successful applicant to Graduate Women NZ and relevant branch.
