

The Joan Dingley Memorial Scholarship in Mycology

Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Mycology.

Level of Study

Postgraduate.

Purpose

The Joan Dingley Memorial Scholarship in Mycology promotes mycological research at Massey University.

Background

Funds for the scholarship were provided from an endowment from the late Joan Dingley, a prominent New Zealand mycologist, with additional funding raised through the Massey University Foundation.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is up to \$6000 as funds permit, tenable for a single academic year.

Payment is made in two equal instalments.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship is offered each year.

Eligibility

Applicants must be enrolled in a Master of Science programme at Massey University and undertaking a minimum of 30 credits research in mycology.

Selection Criteria

The selection criterion is academic merit.

Supporting statements and the research topic may be taken into consideration.

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of a College of Sciences sub-committee.

The University Scholarships Committee has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, so long as those scholarships permit co-tenure.
