Level of Study

Postgraduate

Purpose

The Phyllis Irene Grey Fellowships in Veterinary Science – Postgraduate supports female veterinary science students with a particular interest in animal health research.

Background

These Fellowships are established under the terms of the Will of the late Phyllis Irene Grey.

Value and Tenure

The value of the fellowship shall be up to \$3,000 per annum depending on available funds.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one fellowship is awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must be female veterinary science students pursuing postgraduate level study at Massey University.

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on academic merit and the proposed research to be undertaken during the tenure of the fellowship. Financial need will also be considered.

Selection Committee

The fellowship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of a selection panel comprising of the Dean of Postgraduate Studies and a panel of senior School of Veterinary Science staff.

Conditions of the Fellowship

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.

The Committee may decline to award any scholarships in any year if there are no applicants of sufficient merit to warrant an award.
