

Rider Levett Bucknall Professional Quantity Surveyor of the Year Scholarship

Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Construction, Quantity Surveying.

Level of Study

Undergraduate.

Purpose

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial support and an opportunity for a second or third year Bachelor of Construction student majoring in Quantity Surveying to gain work experience.

Background

The Scholarship was established in 2010 and is financed by Rider Levett Bucknall.

Value and Tenure

The value of a scholarship is \$3,500 to be used to assist in paying the recipient's fees and study costs.

The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- studying on the Auckland campus.
- enrolled in the second or third year of a Bachelor of Construction majoring in Quantity Surveying at Massey University.

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit.
- leadership qualities and/or commitment to the community or sporting activities.
- character qualities including but not limited to an openness and willingness to learn, the ability to learn from experiences, and a high level of determination.
- a strong interest in automation and control systems.

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of Rider Levett Bucknall Construction Programme Committee.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Short-listed candidates may be invited to an interview with the Construction Programme Committee.

The recipients will receive summer vacation employment with Rider Levett Bucknall (located in Auckland). The scholarship will therefore be awarded on the condition that applicants are committed to being available for full time summer vacation employment commencing around mid to late November, through to late February. Rider Levett Bucknall will accommodate holiday plans of up to 2 weeks during this period where requested.

Any conditions of employment relating to this scholarship remain a contractual issue purely between Rider Levett Bucknall and the recipient (employee).

Payment will be made in March following the completion of summer employment at Rider Levett Bucknall. Payment will not be made until such time enrolment and study for the relevant academic year has been confirmed.

Upon graduation Rider Levett Bucknall may also make an offer of full-time employment.

Rider Levett Bucknall is not obligated to make an award if in any year when there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
