Focus

Research in International Agribusiness

Level of Study

Postgraduate

Purpose

The Alistair Betts Scholarship provides financial support to students who undertake research in an international agribusiness topic that enhances New Zealand exports.

Background

This scholarship was established to honour the memory of Alistair Betts who, when employed by the New Zealand Dairy Board during the 1980s, pioneered access for New Zealand dairy products through South East and Southern Asia.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship will be determined each year from the interest earned on the capital and is typically \$5,000. The tenure is for one academic year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year

Eligibility

Applicants must be studying postgraduate agribusiness at Massey University and undertaking research on a topic that affects New Zealand exports.

Preference may be given to full time students, though self-funded part time students will also be considered

Selection Criteria

The award of the scholarship will be based on the relevance of the research and how the research project aligns with international marketing of agribusiness products.

Selection Committee

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarship Committee, College of Sciences, and the leader of the Agribusiness postgraduate programme.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The scholarship, may be held, in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, as long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure

The selection panel has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.
