### Scholarship Regulations

#### **Focus**

Physics

#### **Level of Study**

Undergraduate, Second Year

#### **Purpose**

The Scion Research Institute Physics Scholarship supports second-year physics students.

#### **Background**

This scholarship was established by the former New Zealand Forest Research Institute (now Scion Research) and the former Department of Physics.

#### **Value and Tenure**

The value of the scholarship is determined each year from the interest earned on the capital and is tenable for a single academic year.

#### **Typical Number on Offer**

One scholarship is typically offered each year.

#### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be enrolled for the second-year majoring requirements in physics.

#### **Selection Criteria**

The selection criterion is academic merit.

#### **Selection Panel**

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of a panel of Physics academic staff.

The selection panel has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

### **Conditions of the Scholarship**

The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.
