Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Veterinary Science

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

To support Bachelor of Veterinary Science students through their fourth and fifth year of study.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is \$2,000 and is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship is awarded per year.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be in their fourth or fifth year of the Bachelor of Veterinary Science degree at Massey University
- be from a family that resides in the area currently serviced by the Bay of Islands Veterinary Services at the time of application
- have a preference for working in rural practice after graduation, with a particular interest in production animal practice and be able to demonstrate that interest

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on academic merit and the applicant's performance in an interview.

Selection Panel

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Bay of Islands Veterinary Services.

Conditions of the Scholarship

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview, which will be held in the mid semester break during semester one, in either one of the Bay of Islands Veterinary Services clinics. Applicants will be expected to travel to the interview at their own expense. The successful applicant will be expected to spend time seeing practice with veterinarians of the Bay of Islands Veterinary Services during the year the scholarship is granted.
