Bursary Regulations

Focus

Veterinary science.

Level of Study

Undergraduate.

Purpose

The Henrietta J. Peacock Bursary provides financial assistance to students enrolled in a veterinary science degree. It is to be used to defray the living or tuition expenses of deserving students who require additional financial assistance.

Background

This bursary was established by a donation from the estate of Henrietta Jane Peacock.

Value and Tenure

The value of the bursary will be \$1,000.

The bursary is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

The number of bursaries offered each year varies depending on how much funding is available.

Eligibility

Applicants must be enrolled in a Bachelor of Veterinary Science degree at Massey University.

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit.
- financial need.

Selection Committee

The bursary is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Veterinary Programmes Scholarship Committee.

Conditions of the Bursary

The bursary may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.

The University Scholarships Committee has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

At the discretion of the University all, or part, of the annual interest may be reinvested in order to maintain the value of the capital fund or the value of the award for subsequent years.
