

# Sustainable Development Goals Scholarship

## Scholarship Regulations

### **Focus**

Enrolment in the Master of Sustainable Development Goals

### **Level of Study**

Postgraduate

### **Purpose**

To encourage and support students who plan a career in sustainable development to enrol in the Master of Sustainable Development Goals Programme

### **Value and Tenure**

The value of the scholarship is \$5,000 which will be allocated to the student fees account to assist with the payment of the tuition and non-tuition fees.

The scholarship is offered once only in the first year of enrolment.

### **Typical Number on Offer**

One

### **Eligibility**

Applicants:

- Must be intending to enrol full time in the Master of Sustainable Development Goals Programme
- Have applied for admission into the Master of Sustainable Development Goals Programme by 30 November

The scholarship is open to both domestic and international students.

## **Selection Criteria**

The selection committee will consider the following:

- The applicant's academic transcript showing the GPA of the qualifying degree
- Applicant CV (3 pages, maximum).
- Personal statement by the applicant (up to 400 words) regarding their interest in and commitment to sustainable development.

## **Selection Panel**

The selection committee will comprise of the Head of Academic Unit (or nominee) and two academic staff involved in teaching into the Master of Sustainable Development Goals.

## **Conditions of the Scholarship**

Students must enrol in at least one of the courses 131704 and / or 131709.

The selection committee may take account of other scholarships and bursaries held by the applicant with a view to achieving a reasonable distribution of available monies among qualifying candidates.
