

Pendella Award

Award Regulations

Focus

Agriculture, Wool Industry

Level of Study

Undergraduate

Purpose

The Pendella Award assists students who have no financial sponsorship and are facing financial hardship.

Background

This award is provided from a fund set up by the Scott family of Pendella Station, Ranfurly.

Value and Tenure

The value of the award is determined each year from the interest earned on the capital. The award is offered annually, and the tenure is for a single academic year.

Typical Number on Offer

One award is typically offered each year.

Eligibility

Applicants must be undertaking an undergraduate degree in agriculture and show a keen interest to develop a career within the wool industry.

Preference may be given to degree students in their third year of study

Selection Criteria

The selection criterion is a demonstrated interest in the wool industry and financial need.

In recommending the award of a bursary the selection committee may take account of other scholarships and bursaries held by the applicant with a view to achieving a reasonable distribution of available monies among qualifying candidates.

Selection Panel

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee, College of Sciences.

The University Scholarships Committee has the right to refrain from making an award if there are no suitable applicants and its decision is final.

The Chair of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee will inform the Scott family of the award recipient each year.

Conditions of the Award

The award may be held in conjunction with other scholarships, bursaries or awards, so long as those scholarships, bursaries or awards permit co-tenure.

At the discretion of the University all, or part, of the annual interest may be reinvested in order to maintain the value of the capital fund or the value of the award for subsequent years.
