Scholarship Regulations

Background

The scholarship is supported by a donation of \$7,000 from the William Milverton Trust.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship will be determined on the interest earned on the investment.
The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Typically, one scholarship will be awarded per year

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- domiciled in New Zealand
- enrolled full-time at Massey University for an undergraduate or honours degree in agriculture (paper prefixes of 112, 117, 119, 189, 283, 284 or 285)

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit
- the benefit to the applicant and their study in receiving this scholarship, and how well the applicant meets the conditions and intentions of the scholarship

Priority will be given to those candidates who have completed all or part of the practical work requirement for the degree.

In recommending the award, the scholarship committee will take account of other scholarships and bursaries held with a view to achieving a reasonable distribution of monies among qualifying candidates.

Selection Panel

The scholarship is awarded by the University Scholarships Committee on the recommendation of the Applied Academic Programmes Scholarships Committee, College of Sciences.

Conditions of the Scholarship

The Committee may decline to award any scholarships in any year if there are no applicants of sufficient merit to warrant an award.

At the discretion of the University all, or part, of the annual interest may be reinvested in order to maintain the value of the capital fund or the value of the award for subsequent years.
